Whole school Rules

Whole school rules are encouraged by all staff. They are displayed around the school: are reinforced and referred to regularly in assemblies and everyday school life.

Rewards

Individual Rewards

All children may gain an individual reward for behaviour, effort, quality of work or politeness in class and around school. This may come in the form of:

- Verbal praise
- Housepoints
- 'Good To Be Green' card
- 'Good To Be Green Again' tokens
- 'Good To Be Gold' card
- 'Golden Time' (half termly)
- Stickers
- Table points
- Written comments
- Star/Pupil of the week
- Good work sent to other classes/teachers
- Head Teacher awards
- Bravery award (first aid) Lunchtime
- Healthy eating tokens Lunchtime
- Marvellous Me an individual or group/class praised via a message sent from school to the parent/carer's device

Class Rewards

Classes working together as a team are rewarded with a privilege card.

- Lining up
- Moving around school appropriately
- Good behaviour during lunchtimes
- Team work in lessons
- Changing for PE

If a class collects 10 privilege cards they are awarded 15 minutes extra playtime together.

Golden Time

At the end of every half term, all children that have received at least 2 'Good To Be Green' cards are rewarded with 'Golden Time'. Here, they choose from a selection of activities such as arts/craft, a film or sport to enjoy.

House Awards

Children receive housepoints for producing good work.

- The House Cup is presented in Friday Award's Assembly to the house that has collected the most housepoints during that week.
- Sport's Day points for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places are awarded and the house with the most points win the annual Sport's Day House Shield.

Celebration/Achievement Assemblies

Each Friday, children have the opportunity to share their achievements from out of school activities. Children should bring in their certificates, trophies or awards by Thursday so that it can be presented to them during the whole school assembly.

Each half term an Award's Assembly is held to present certificates and awards achieved in school.
