SCHOOL POLICY STATEMENT ON SMOKING

(THIS INCLUDES E-CIGARETTES)

INTRODUCTION

In November 2004 the Government's White Paper "Choosing Health" was published. It recommended smoking restrictions in all workplaces and enclosed public places. Since then new legislation has been introduced banning smoking in these places.

NO SMOKING AREAS

Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the premises nor anywhere on site. The boundary being the school's private grounds, which start in-line with the barrier (car park) at the front of the school. All areas within the fencing of the side and back of the grounds.

Staff on school business will not smoke in the presence of pupils and colleagues.

APPLICATION

This policy applies to all staff, visitors and contractors to the school.
