



World Book Day - Thursday 5th March 2026


We are really looking forward to celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 5th March.

The theme this year is 'Go All In' as 2026 is The National Year of Reading. This is a national campaign to get more people reading and as part of this, children will have the opportunity to take part in different reading activities throughout the year.

On World Book Day, one of the activities the children will be taking part in is a book sharing event with their peers to help them find new authors and books they would like to try. We would ask children to dress up for this occasion in smart/fancy clothes - there is no need to go out to buy anything in addition to what you have at home.
