



### My child feels safe at this school








My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively


My child has not been bullied


The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year


When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly


I have not raised concerns




The school has high expectations for my child




The school lets me know how my child is doing


There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school


My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school


The school supports my child's wider personal development

Thank you to all the parents who completed the parent questionnaire. Overall, the feedback is positive and it is pleasing to see that a large majority of parents who responded tell us that their child feels happy and safe in school. We will continue to let you know in our half termly summary what your children have been learning which you will see in the newsletter. Programmes of Study will also provide you with future learning.

Parents Evenings at school are a great way for you to meet the teacher and discuss success and next steps. Looking at the work in your child's book the night before allows you to see how hard your child is working and know what questions to ask the teacher when you visit.

We work hard with the children about their behaviour in school, following our PROUD expectations. Children receive lessons in PSHE and as part of assemblies to focus on weekly behaviour focuses, mental health and wellbeing awareness weeks and anti-bullying weeks. Where we have 51% of parents who are unsure about the term 'bullying', we will look at how we can support you with understanding this term.

We will continue to look at ways to promote all of the enrichment activities we celebrate in school and share the success of children's awards outside of school too. Having our Sports Coach this year has enabled us to focus on a variety of sporting activities at the end of the school day for each year group as well as encouraging active play
