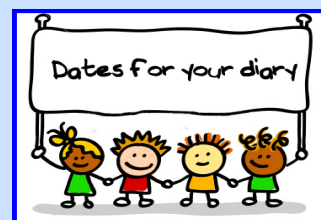

Best Practice

We have been working with external school improvement partners to ensure that our priorities to make rapid advances in our practice are validated. We would like to share with you feedback from our visit on the 22nd June:

"Learning visits were undertaken across the school with year group leads. The quality of education observed aligned closely with the evaluations provided by school leaders and supported the view that actions taken through the school's improvement strategy are beginning to have a positive impact on classroom practice. "

"Learning environments were notably consistent in both approach and presentation. Classrooms and shared learning spaces were purposeful, well organised and conducive to learning. Expectations appeared clear and pupils demonstrated familiarity with established routines and structures. The consistency observed reflects the significant work undertaken by leaders to establish a coherent approach across the school. "

"The practice observed reflected the priorities identified through the school's self-evaluation. There is evidence that actions taken by senior leaders are creating greater consistency in classroom practice and enhancing the learning experience for pupils. The visit provided encouraging signs that the school's curriculum and teaching priorities are increasingly becoming embedded within day-to-day practice. "
