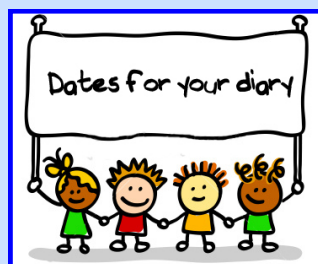

School Safety Reminder: Responsible Parking & Driving

We have recently received a serious concern from a parent regarding a near miss this morning. Please do not stop on the zebra crossing to drop your child off for school. Be considerate and:

- **Avoid parking on pavements** - these are vital walking routes for children.
- **Do not park on double yellow lines** - this restricts visibility and creates hazards.
- **Respect blue badge spaces** - only use them if you are entitled to do so.
- **Drive slowly and carefully near the school** - children may be crossing unexpectedly.
- **Consider parking a little further away** and walking the last part of the journey.



We continue to work with the local authority to monitor the area more closely, but your co-operation is also essential. It is important to work together with this to ensure every child arrives and leaves school safely.
