



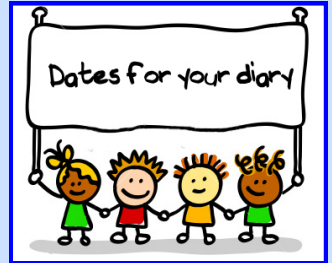

## Class Photographs

On Friday 8th May, Years 3, 4 and 5 will have their class photographs taken. On this day, Year 5 children will need to come in full school uniform and bring their PE kit in a separate bag to change into.

Year 6 class photographs will follow on Friday 22nd May. Staff will be speaking to the children about the dress code for the Friendship Photographs, to ensure everyone is comfortable and appropriately dressed. The dress code for this event is smart casual. Below are some suggestions:

- Tops: Collared shirts, polo shirts, blouses, or smart T-shirts (please avoid football tops).
- Bottoms: Trousers, smart jeans, skirts, or dresses (please ensure skirts/dresses are not too long to avoid tripping hazards).
- Footwear: Sensible shoes, such as loafers, flats, or smart trainers (as the children will be outside for break and lunch).

### Sun Safety! (Even on cloudy days)

Now we are into the warmer months, please ensure that your child has a re-fillable water bottle, with their name and class on, to use throughout the school day to keep themselves hydrated!

In the months of May, June July and September, optional uniform is:

### Year 6 SATs

It's almost here! Year 6 pupils will be taking their SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) week beginning **Monday 11th May**. These will test children's knowledge and understanding of the Key Stage 2 programme of study in English: Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling and Maths. The tests will provide information about how your child is progressing, compared to children the same age nationally, and support the transition to secondary schools.

SATs week will feel very similar to other assessment weeks in Year 6 in terms of rooms used and the structure of the assessments. Assessments will take place during the morning sessions and children will still have break and lunch as normal. In school, we have discussed with the children how it is normal to feel worried about assessments however if they have concerns about how they are feeling it is important to share these with an adult.

### Bicycle Helmets

We have noticed an increase in children riding their bikes to school without wearing a cycle helmet.

For everyone's safety, we kindly remind families that children should always wear a properly fitted helmet when cycling to and from school. Helmets play an important role in protecting children and helping to reduce the risk of injury.
