
Inset Day - School Closed to all children

Reminder: Vaccinations in School - 7th October 2025



This marvellous book is about a girl called Matilda Pages, nick-named Tilly. She has lived with her grandparents ever since her mother disappeared. Tilly finds out she can talk to her favourite book characters and follow them in their mythical worlds with the magic of bookwandering. She visits Alice from Wonderland and Anne from Anne of Green Gables.

I think that this is a magical book full of adventure. It is like no other book I have ever read before. It is beautifully brilliant and takes you on a breath-taking adventure.

Secondary School Applications for September 2026

Closing Date - 31st October 2025



Applying for a secondary school place for your child is an important step in your child's educational journey. For those encountering this for the first time we know that this process may feel a little overwhelming. However, there is plenty of help and advice to support all parents applying.

It is advised that parents submit their application before the end of Autumn 1 on **Thursday 23rd October 2025 - particularly if you think you may need assistance**.

The online portal is now open for applications and the deadline for applications is 31st October 2025.

All details needed to make your online application may be found on the Walsall Council website.

Home—Schools and Learning—Apply for a Secondary School Place

Online applications are made to the local authority where you reside and pay your Council Tax to, for example, Sandwell, Birmingham, Wolverhampton, etc.

Residents in these boroughs will need to create an account, if you have not already done so, prior to completion. If you wish to speak to us in school please do so before **Thursday 23rd October 2025**.

If you apply late, you may not get a place at one of your preferred schools.

If you live outside Walsall, you should complete an application from your home local authority (even if you are applying for a Walsall school).

Below are the upcoming open days at just some of our local schools. Remember to explore school websites, read school admissions policies and entry criteria. This will help you understand how schools make their admissions decisions.
