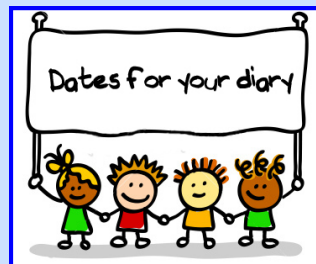

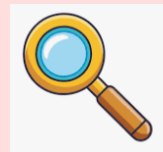

Playschemes

Sun Safety! (Even on cloudy days)

Now we are into the warmer months, please ensure that your child has a re-fillable water bottle, with their name and class on, to use throughout the school day to keep themselves hydrated!

In the months of May, June July and September, optional uniform is:

- Grey shorts with a polo shirt (no tie is required with a summer polo shirt)



It is advisable for your child to have a cap to wear when outside at playtime/lunchtime to protect them from the effects of the sun. Please **do not** send in sunglasses - these are easily broken and can cause hazards on the playground. Also please remember to apply sunscreen before the school day. Thank you.

Polite Reminder: Special Items

A reminder that children should not be bringing into school any special items from home such as toys, keyrings and jewellery. If non-school items are brought in by your child, they will be confiscated by staff and you will have to collect them from the school office at the end of the day.
