Drop Off and Collection

An email was sent on Wednesday 3rd September regarding drop off and collection. The school doors will open at 8.45am; children need to be in class by 8.55am for their registration mark and learning time. Gates are locked at 8.55am prompt. School finishes at 3.30pm. If children are not collected by 3:45pm they will be taken to Treehouse. There will be a charge for children taken to Treehouse.

Children will have been told today by their class teacher where to come into school in the morning. A member of the senior leadership team is available at the gate.

At the end of the school day all children will leave via their designated doors - If your child will be collected by someone other than parents/carers, please make sure that the school office has been notified of any changes so that the collection list can be updated accordingly.





Full school uniform, including sensible black shoes with black soles should be worn at all times, apart from your child's PE day when PE kit should be worn. Please remember to clearly label your child's belongings - if it isn't named we cannot return lost items to your child! Unnamed lost property can be found by the school office. Please do not allow your child to add key rings or charms to their school bag - these are easily lost around school. ****

Food Allergies, Food Dudes and Lunch

Please do not send your child with nut based products.

We have a number of children with severe allergies to different types of nuts – this can be extremely dangerous resulting in potentially life-threatening anaphylaxis.

As a healthy school please ensure that mid-morning snacks are fruit and vegetables. Chocolate, crisps and sugary snacks should not be sent into school for a snack – a small treat may be included in their lunch box.





When sending your child to school don't forget cutlery! Whether they need a spoon for yogurt or a fork for pasta, having the right utensils makes lunchtime much easier for everyone. Please ensure any cutlery you send in is plastic and reusable.

Water bottles should be re-usable and NOT made of glass or metals. They will be able to be topped up throughout the day.



Medication





This is a reminder of the current procedures for administering medication in school, following updated statutory guidance already shared with families.

Prescription Medication

If your child needs prescribed medication during the school day:

It must be brought to the school office by a parent or carer.








Children are not permitted to carry medication, except for pre-approved cases (e.g. inhalers or EpiPens), which must still be logged with the office.

Over-the-Counter Medication

We are unable to administer non-prescription medications (e.g. Calpol, antihistamines) unless they have been prescribed by a doctor with a clear label. If your child requires such medication, please consult your GP and follow the prescription procedure.

These rules are in place to ensure pupil safety and comply with national safeguarding guidance.
