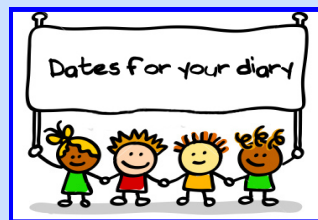

Classroom Questioning Techniques

To encourage participation and check understanding, teachers use a range of questioning techniques. These include cold calling (selecting pupils to answer), random selection using lollypop sticks or a wheel, providing thinking time before answering, limiting hands-up responses, group discussions with pupil feedback, and targeted questions for individual learners. These approaches help ensure all pupils are engaged, challenged and involved in their learning.

- Children should come to school on this day in their PE Kits.

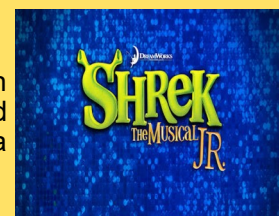
