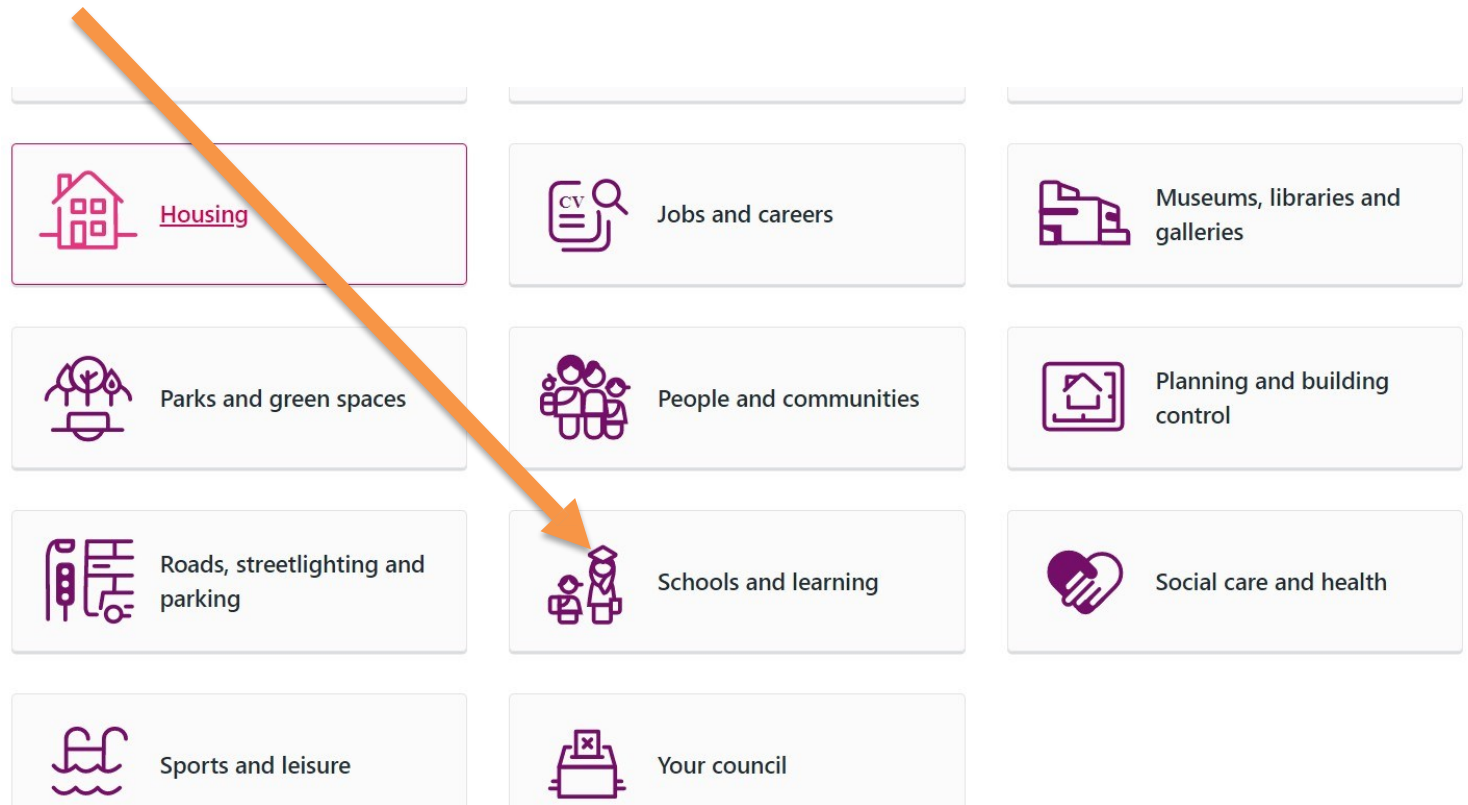

Apply for a primary school place
Apply for a September 2021 start for reception or year 1, or transfer from infant to junior school (year 3).


Apply for a secondary school place
Apply for a September 2022 start if your child is due to transfer to a secondary school (year 7).


Moving to a different school
Also called a mid-year admission or transfer, you can apply to move your child to a different school at a non-standard point.

Applying for schools outside Walsall

If you live in Walsall but any of your preferred schools are outside Walsall Borough, you can still apply in the same way. Walsall Council runs a co-ordinated admissions scheme with neighbouring councils and admissions authorities, so you only have to complete one application.

Benefits of online applications

- Anytime access – from Monday 2nd September 2024 – Thursday 31st October 2024 for on-time applications
- Paperless applications
- Easy to use, secure and safe system.
- You will receive your offer by email on National Offer Day 3rd March 2025.
- You can amend your application after it has been submitted up until the closing date of 31st October 2024.

Top tips

- Ensure that you submit your application by 31st October 2024.
- Do your research on prospective schools.
- Read the on-line information for parents' booklet on our website [School admissions | Walsall Council](#)
- You can list up to 5 school preferences, we recommend that you use all 5 preferences
- If your preferred schools are all oversubscribed and a place cannot be offered, your child will be placed on the waiting list and Walsall Council will offer a place at the closest school to the child's home address with a vacancy.
- Some schools require supplementary information forms, please check the admission criteria for each school.
- We do not advise you to list 5 grammar schools – this will limit your chances of being offered a preferred school.
- Include at least 1 local school that you feel your child would have qualified for in previous years.

Result of a late application:

It is extremely important that you submit your application by 31 October 2024.

- Late applications are processed after all those submitted on-time.
- Your child might not be offered a place at **any** of your preferred schools, even though you may live very close to the school and have other children attending there.
- Your child could be allocated a place at an alternative Walsall school which may not be your most local, or one that you would have chosen.
- It is unlikely that a place would become available at your preferred school from the waiting list.

- Read the information for parents' booklet.
- You **MUST** submit your application by 31st October 2024.
- List 5 school preferences on your application.
- Some schools require supplementary information forms – they must also be submitted on time, **directly to the school.**
